## FROM THE (FUTURE) PASTOR'S DESK

Beloved Church of Lakeview United Church of Christ,  
 Grace and peace to you in the name of our still-speaking God.

These days, Tyler and I find ourselves surrounded by moving plans, and two semi confused Great Danes, Maui and Major, trying to understand why their world seems to be relocating to cardboard boxes. We are hard at work preparing for this next chapter of life and ministry together.

At the same time, my mother and I recently announced that our family bakery, Beth's Bakery, will be closing after 30 years, with our final day being July 31st. It is a unique ending of an era for our family and for many in the Wapakoneta community who have celebrated life's milestones with us through the years. I'm excited to share some Beth's Bakery cookies with you on June 14, my first Sunday worshiping with you.

During June and July, Tyler and I will be sharing our time between Cincinnati and Wapakoneta as we navigate this season of transition. We will have temporary housing in the Cincinnati area as we continue preparing our Wapakoneta home to sell while also searching for a permanent home closer to Lakeview. During the workweek I will remain in the Cincinnati area through Thursday evenings before returning to Wapakoneta for bakery responsibilities on Fridays and Saturdays through the bakery's final season. In the midst of all of this transition, I also want to brag just a little bit about my husband, Tyler. Alongside balancing work, moving plans, and everything else this season holds, he continues working toward finishing his social work degree at The Ohio State, and this year he made the Dean's List. Needless to say, I am incredibly proud of him. We deeply appreciate your prayers during these next couple of months, and we look forward to being more fully settled among you in the months ahead.

Even in the midst of all this transition, these summer months are already shaping up to be deeply meaningful and sacred ones.

## FROM THE (FUTURE) PASTOR'S DESK. ....continued

In May I had the joy of attending the SONKA Spring Gathering, where it was wonderful seeing many familiar faces from my Heartland Conference connections, as well as many of you from Lakeview. One of the highlights of the gathering was hearing from the General Minister and President of the United Church of Christ, Rev. Dr. Karen Georgia Thompson. As always, she was prophetic, inspiring, thoughtful, and deeply pastoral. Listening to her reminded me once again why I love this denomination so deeply – a church continually striving toward justice, compassion, extravagant welcome, and courageous hope. I would absolutely love for us to someday welcome Rev. Dr. Karen Georgia Thompson to Lakeview. What a meaningful and inspiring visit that would be for our church family.

The beginning of June carries several moments that feel especially sacred to me personally and vocationally.

From June 1-3, I will be in Washington, D.C. as a national advocate with the Alzheimer's Association at the Alzheimer's Impact Movement National Advocacy Forum. During that time, we will meet with members of Congress to advocate for those living with Alzheimer's and dementia, caregivers, and those seeking diagnosis and support services.

This work is deeply personal to me. As many of you heard during my candidate sermon, my grandmother battled both Lewy Body Dementia and Alzheimer's disease. Advocacy work like this allows me to continue honoring her story while working toward dignity, support, research, and compassionate care for others walking similar roads.

Then, on Sunday, June 7, I will be ordained into Christian ministry within the United Church of Christ.

What an exciting and sacred milestone this is in my life and ministry journey. To finally be reaching this point after years of discernment, formation, ministry, learning, and growth feels both deeply humbling and deeply joyful.

Let me once again extend an open invitation to my Lakeview family to attend my ordination service. The service begins at 3:00 p.m., followed by a meal and reception afterward. I already understand there is a group planning to attend, which means more to me than I can adequately express.

And then comes June 8 – my first official day serving as your pastor.

It feels especially meaningful that this new chapter together begins during Pride Month.

Nearly 14 years ago, it was the witness of the United Church of Christ at a Pride event in Columbus that first introduced me to this denomination. Before I ever stepped inside a UCC sanctuary, I encountered people proclaiming with boldness and sincerity: **“God is still speaking.”**

That is why these words, **“No matter who you are or where you are on life's journey, you are welcome here,”** are so deeply important to me – and why I believe it is so important that we continue proclaiming them boldly, compassionately, and publicly.

Those words are not simply branding to me.  
They are Gospel.

As someone whose life has been transformed by that welcome, Pride Month will always hold sacred significance in my faith story. I am deeply grateful for the ways Lakeview embodies extravagant welcome not merely as a slogan, but as a lived expression of the Kingdom of God. I look forward to standing alongside you at Pride events this June and July as we continue proclaiming God's radically inclusive love to the world around us.

This July, our nation marks 250 years of history.

I know how quickly conversations surrounding nation, politics, identity, and public life can become difficult and divisive. Yet I also believe the Church is called to create spaces where people can gather honestly, compassionately, thoughtfully, and safely with one another.

So perhaps my prayer for us this summer is this:

May we keep our eyes heavenward.

May we continue becoming people shaped more by love than fear.

May we remember that compassion is holy work.

And may we continue being witnesses to the still-speaking God in a world aching for grace, justice, mercy, and hope.

Friends, I truly believe the Spirit is already doing a new thing among us.

May we find peace in this season of transition.

May we discover comfort in community.

May we trust the God who continues calling us forward.

And may we journey together with courage, imagination, compassion, and hope.

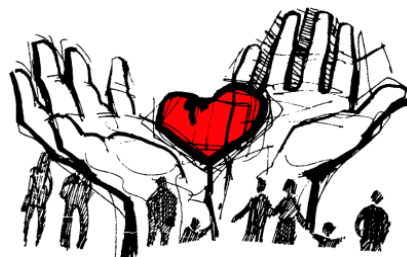

## ACTION IN MISSION—(A.I.M.)

### June Mission of the Month

#### FAMILY PROMISE



The June mission is Family Promise, a cooperative of many faith communities working toward providing intermediate care to homeless families as they make their way through a program of education, job training, life skills preparation, and a housing search. This program is found in 39 states, with 4500 partnering congregations. A majority of these families become homeless because of eviction, health problems leading to job disruption, or family disruption, such as divorce, abandonment, or domestic violence. Given the choice of buying food or paying the high housing costs encountered in Warren County, most families choose food, leading to eviction and foreclosure. Many of the parents have low wage jobs without benefits, and any unforeseen problem such as illness can lead to homelessness. Prescreening of families is done prior to admission to the program to qualify need.

Once in the program, families were being hosted by various churches on a weekly rotational basis until they obtained housing (Lakeview assists St. Patrick's Episcopal Church in Lebanon on Monday nights). A day center in Lebanon is where staff had been housed, and this center offered programming, job and housing searches, public assistance applications, showers, and laundry facilities. The center was also the transportation hub, where rides were provided, if needed, for family members to and from school, jobs, and other places.

Fast forward to May, 2024. The headquarters for Family Promise is now at 600 Cincinnati Ave., Lebanon. The day center is housed there, and as the guests are now being hosted at this center, a renovated motel where each family has its own room. There is a large kitchen and communal living space for all to relax in the evenings. This has made daily life much better for the families.

Besides our offering, which can help to defray expenses for so many items needed to operate the program in Warren County, there is another way we can help. Family Promise will hold it's annual Run4Home 5K and Kid's Fun Run on July 4th at Armco Park. Proceeds will support Family Promise programs. One of these is Christmas in July, to help children who have been in the Family Promise program feel ready for school, as well as continued updates on the new campus. See the Family Promise website for further information and/or to sign up. The website also gives information on future events, such as Tailgate for Home (10/18).

Washington United Church of Christ is located in a suburb of Cincinnati where residents face great financial challenges. The congregation is dedicated to providing outreach ministries to their neighbors in Camp Washington and surrounding low-income neighborhoods.

Washington UCC strives to partner with the citizens of Camp Washington to create a community that is safe and clean, where people have enough food, decent housing, opportunities for education and work, and live in an environment that nurtures all families.

Outreach Programs include a store where residents can obtain clothing and household goods at no cost, community meals, a homework club for kids, boxes of food at Thanksgiving and their annual “Gifts to the Manger” program providing Christmas gifts for kids.

The Back to School program provides children connected to Washington UCC with school uniforms, hygiene items, a backpack, and school supplies.

### FAMILY PROMISE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Family Promise provides temporary housing to homeless families while assisting them in securing permanent housing, employment, and other needed services. Lakeview assists host church St. Pat's Episcopal Church in Lebanon during their rotation week, and Lakeview handles Monday nights. This happens 4 times a year at the renovated facility on 600 Cincinnati Ave. in Lebanon.

**Next Date: Monday, June 15, 2026**

Volunteers are needed to:



–Provide a dish for the evening meal (4 volunteers).

–Host the families during evening hours (about 5 p.m. to about 8:45 p.m.)—2 volunteers needed. This involves helping to set out dinner and clean up, as well as hanging out with the guests and maybe doing activities with the kids (bring a craft or art project if you wish, depending on the ages of the children).

–Spend the night—2 volunteers needed. You will have your own space to sleep. There are no real duties except to make sure everyone is accounted for, turn off lights and lock up the common area, and be there in case any emergencies occur (you will have emergency contact numbers). In the morning you are free to leave as soon as you need to.

## Lakeview Capital Campaign

On Sunday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at the congregational meeting of Lakeview UCC, a vote was taken to extend the 2022 Capital Campaign. Now that the second mortgage has been paid off (February 24, 2025), extending the campaign will enable the church to gather funds for much needed property projects.

In a few years, the church will need the roof shingles replaced and that will also be a major expense. Due to the water damage from the ice dams in February we may need to absorb some of this expense that will not be covered by insurance (deductible, etc.).

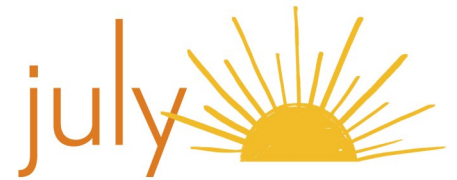
