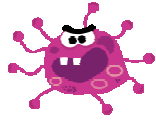


Lakeview Preschool's



Illness Policy

Goal: Provide a safe, supportive learning environment for students and staff for in-person learning.

Strategies: Lakeview Preschool will take a variety of actions every day to prevent the spread of infectious diseases, including the virus that causes Covid-19.

1. **Clean and Disinfection**

Staff will clean surfaces several times a day to reduce the risk of germs spreading by touching surfaces.

2. **Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette**

Staff will teach and reinforce proper handwashing to lower the risk of spreading viruses. Staff will reinforce covering coughs and sneezes.

3. **Ventilation Systems**

Lakeview Preschool has purchased and installed air purifiers for the classrooms that reduce 99.9% of all viruses and bacteria in the air and on and under surfaces.

4. **Staying Home When Sick**

Students and Staff with symptoms of infectious diseases including Covid-19, influenza, RSV, and gastrointestinal infections should stay home and get tested for Covid-19. Staying home when sick can lower the risk of spreading diseases. Please refer to the attached Quick Guides if your child is exposed to Covid-19 or tests positive for Covid-19. Also, please notify the office if your child has symptoms of any communicable disease.

5. **Staying Up to Date on Vaccinations**

Staying up to date on routine vaccinations is essential to prevent illness from many different infections. Please contact your child's primary doctor or the local health department for more information on what vaccines are available.

6. **Do Not Bring a Child to School with these Symptoms**

Temperature of 100 degrees F

Diarrhea

Severe Coughing

Difficult or Rapid Breathing

Yellowish Skin or Eyes

Redness of the eye, obvious discharge, matted eyelashes

Untreated Skin Patches, Unusual Spots or Rashes

Unusually Dark Urine or Gray or White Stools

Stiff Neck with an Elevated Temperature

Evidence of Untreated Lice, Scabies, or other Parasitic Infestation

Vomiting

Sore Throat or Difficulty Swallowing

If a child shows any of these symptoms at school, the staff will call the parents to come and get the child. We appreciate your cooperation with this matter.

In conclusion, we are working to go above and beyond to ensure cleanliness and safety in our building. We will stay up to date with CDC guidelines and The Warren County Health Department. You will be informed of any changes to our policy. The Director will notify the local health department and parents of any communicable diseases that develop in the building.
